A YEAR OF CREATIVITY, COLLABORATION AND IMMERSIVE LEARNING

After an exciting first year, the **SHOOT Project – Students Have Optimal Opportunities Together** is already showing strong results across Europe. Our partnership has brought to life the idea of learning through digital photography, turning images into powerful tools for storytelling, inclusion and discovery.

PROGRESS SO FAR

Since the launch of the project, students and teachers from Italy, Spain, Greece, Poland and Estonia have been exploring how photography can make education more engaging and inclusive.

Through the SHOOT Roadmap, partners have created digital handbooks for students and teachers, offering step-by-step guidance on using photography as a learning tool.

More than 400 students and educators took part in the first surveys and workshops, helping shape the project's next steps.

The results of the student surveys confirmed the main themes of the SHOOT Digital Photo Storytelling Methodology:

- **Environmental Sustainability and Biodiversity** – with a focus on marine and river ecosystem conservation.
- **Citizenship and Participation** – highlighting historical memory and civic identity.
- **Cultural Heritage** – exploring craftsmanship and artisanal traditions.

These topics will guide the creation of immersive lessons and photo stories across all partner schools.

ESTONIA MOBILITY: LEARNING THROUGH THE LENS

In September 2025, students and teachers met in Tallinn for the second project mobility hosted by Noored Ühiskonna Heaks.

During the week, participants explored digital storytelling and sustainability, combining creativity with hands-on photography sessions. They developed photo stories around local biodiversity and civic identity, exchanging ideas and inspiration across cultures.

In the months ahead, the SHOOT partners will:

- Finalize the Storytelling Methodology
- Hold immersive workshops in Greece, Spain and Poland
- Test the immersive classroom experience
- Build the photo repository and technical toolkit
